



**The Embassy of the Republic of South Africa in Rome invites applications for the appointment of an Honorary Consul in the Republic of Malta.**

The ideal candidate should be an individual of high standing, well established in the local business and/or social environment, and should possess the following attributes:

- An established network relevant to South African commercial, cultural, and bilateral interests
- High moral character and professional integrity
- Sufficient independent financial means to support the functions of the office
- Proficiency in the local language and English
- Be a permanent resident in Malta

The Honorary Consul will be expected to contribute to the promotion of South African commercial, cultural, and diplomatic interests in the Republic of Malta, to provide limited consular assistance in accordance with applicable regulations, and to serve as a point of contact between South African citizens residing in the country and the Embassy in Rome.

The functions of the Honorary Consul shall be carried out in accordance with the *Vienna Convention on Consular Relations* of 1963, in particular Articles 5, 36, and 37, and under the authority of the Embassy of the Republic of South Africa in Rome.

This is an unpaid honorary position. The appointment is subject to security clearance and approval by the *Department of International Relations and Cooperation* of the Republic of South Africa. Furthermore, it is subject to the approval of the Maltese Authorities.
